Old Business:

Working on reroutes: have spoke to numerous landowners

1st Gristmill: we cut a new trail about 1/3rd of the way down Kipp Rd. Will have some road riding on Kipp. Owner on Bidwell is allowing us to use his property but it will be work - it may have to be next year. Need to mow from powerlines to C5 square valley.

2nd reroute: Mexico Village to Tubbs Rd had no connection. Received 7 new landowners permission to cut new trail: railbed to cole rd, can split off to continue to Pulaski or can go right and head to Sherman Rd, cross 41, to Tubbs (Halsey's).

3rd reroute: not necessary, have permission from landowners - ability to stay on the railbed from Pulaski to CR 41, go through a field to Minkler Rd, need to cut woods.
